Podcast: What If World

Episode: 32: What if sharks had legs?

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[Rising harp scales followed by the What If World theme song.]

Lyrics: What if kittens played the glockenspiel? And what if unicorns were real?

What if you could fly or travel back in time, we welcome you to What If

World. What If World. This is What If World.

Mr. Eric: Hey there, folks, and welcome back to What If World, the show where

your questions and ideas inspire off the cuff stories. I'm Mr. Eric, your

host and today we've got a question from Luka.

Luka: Hi, my name is Luka and I'm five years old. I like Star Wars, and my What

If World question is, what if sharks had legs?

Mr. Eric: Hm. Star Wars? Oh, gosh. I have never heard of Star Wars.

[Record scratch]

Haha! I'm just kidding. Of course I know what that is. And I'm very excited to tell you a story involving sharks with legs and Star Wars somehow. Gosh, you know, that reminds me of a What If World story

called Shark Wars.

[Rising harp scale.]

Mr. Eric: A long time ago, in a galaxy far under the waves, the Shellactic Empire

was ruled by the sharks. Now sharks back then in What If World had stubby little legs that they used to walk around. I guess later they evolve away from using them. But one shark, the ruler of the Shellactic Empire, Shark-Gator, he thought that only sea creatures with legs should be

allowed to live in his castle, the Breath Star.

The Breath Star was a giant rolling ball of coral and stone that they built

to house all the fish that Shark-Gator thought should live there.

Shark-Gator: [Darth Vader breath sound] Breathing the same air as those legless sea

creatures [Darth Vader breath sound] is what makes it so hard for me to

[Darth Vader breath sound] catch my breath. [Darth Vader breath

sound]

Mr. Eric: So he'd only let sharks with legs live inside the Breath Star. Everyone else

just had to get out of the way. Or that giant coral castle would roll right

over their whole town or city.

But there is one little town about as far as you could be from the center of the ocean, named Turtoine. And in that town, where everyone lived under old tortoise shells, there was one little boy shark named Luka Seawalker. Now this little shark's legs were much smaller and flatter than stumpy little legs of his shark ancestors. And yet, all the other kids in

Turtoine thought that was a reason to make fun of him.

Mean kid: Seawalker, more like sea crawler.

Other mean Kid: I think that turtle shell you live under is faster than you.

Mr. Eric: Luka was wiser than most boys and girls his age. He knew they were

teasing him because they were just listening to the lessons of the Shellactic Empire and it taught them that all sharks with legs were important. And all creatures of any other kind were less important.

Mr. Eric: Said Luka.

Kids: [Laugh]

Luka: Um, are you gonna eat me?

Mr. Eric: Asked Luka.

Voice: Heavens no. The Fisheye Knights only fight as a last resort. Besides, I'm

extremely old.

Luka: You were a Fisheye Knight? I've heard of you. You're Megadon Conchobi.

Megadon: Guilty as charged. And if you want to defeat the Shellactic Empire, you're

going to need to learn our ways.

Luka: Oh, I don't know. I talk a lot about making a difference, but look at my

tiny little legs. I can barely walk.

Megadon: I told you, you need to use the Dorse, Luka.

Luka: Yeah, you said that before. I don't know what you're talking about.

What's the Dorse?

Megadon: Dorsal fin. We call it the Dorse but short.

Luka: That's not really short. The Dorse, dorsal, it's the same amount of

[Whistling noise]

A2-Me2: [Whistling]

Megadon: That seems like an unlikely design flaw.

A2-Me2: [Sad whistle]

Luka: He says there's a whole 'nother story that explains why that flaw actually

makes sense but it's too long to tell right now.

Megadon: Oh, well, then. We might as well get to it.

Mr. Eric: Now Megadon was an old shark. It took everything he had just to crawl
